SUBJ: 2-spd transmission housing assembly replacement

Install Service Kit 753-0711 when replacing upper housing part number 619-0017.

Due to the design change on the new housing assembly it will be necessary to drill a hole in the existing torque bracket on the unit in order to install the transmission.

Tools required:


- Electric hand drill
- 5/16" drill bit
- two 1/2" wrenches

Installation instructions:

- 1. Remove the spark plug wire(s) from the spark plug(s).
- 2. Lower cutting deck to its lowest position
- 3. Using a hand drill equipped with a 5/16" drill bit, drill through the top hole of the torque bracket.


## CAUTION: Drill only through the top hole in the torque bracket.

4. Reattach the transmission housing to the torque bracket with hex cap screw, bell washer, and lock nut. The original lower torque bracket bolt must be retained for final assembly.

• The head of the hex bolt **MUST** be placed against the transmission housing as shown in Figure 2.





• Tighten the hex cap screw to secure the transmission housing to the torque bracket. The proper torque setting for this bolt is 20 ft./lbs.
